

## PDF Instructions for your Authors

#### Before Creating a PDF

- Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact **Mariusz Kaczmarek** at [mariusz.kaczmarek@eti.pg.edu.pl](mailto:mariusz.kaczmarek@eti.pg.edu.pl) for the appropriate copyright notice.
- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

#### Creating your PDF eXpress Account

Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress](#)™ site

#### *First-time users should do the following:*

1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
2. Enter the following:
  - **43124X** for the Conference ID
  - your email address
  - a password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

*Previous users* of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
